Perry - #1 @ CBYC, NOR is online, Regatta NOR going up, first event is not PCC's because it was hosted during the summer race week, plan is for 30 boats. Perry 3 overlaps the US SAILING Youth World Qualifier, so a new date is being sought, Perry #4 will most likely be at CAL

The 2008 US SAILING ISAF Youth World Qualifier Regatta, a new multi-class event that will determine the sailors who will represent the U.S. at the 2008 Volvo Youth Sailing ISAF (International Sailing Federation) World Championship, will be hosted this January by Alamitos Bay Yacht Club. Racing will be in Lasers (boys' singlehanded), Laser Radials (girls' singlehanded), 29er (boys' and girls' doublehanded), RS:X (boys' and girls' sailboard) and SL16 catamaran (open multihull).
