Secretary's Report- Cathy Turner

Treasurer's Report: - Mike Segerblom

A. Mike reported that financially it was a quiet period. No checks have come in since our last meeting, but our meeting is early and income comes in later. Mike will write off the Anacapa Yacht Club receivable after this meeting. It is a tight year because of the expense of the new website. Mike projects a negative balance of 1-2 thousand at the end of the year. The Yearbook printing costs \$3,000 a year. We might consider printing a 2 sided/1 page schedule or a poster to replace the printed Racing Calendar and Yearbook next year. Chairman Report: - Andy La Dow

A. Andy La Dow gave an overview of SCYYRA activities. He encouraged more parent participation. The next PCISA meeting is at NHYC on Sept. 9, 2012 and our next SCYYRA meeting will be at Mission Bay Yacht Club on Nov. 3, 2012. Andy La Dow gave an overview of SCYYRA Sailing Team. The Team is a select group of the top junior sailors from San Diego to Santa Barbara. They are invited to participate in advanced sailing clinics and will be recognized for their sailing accomplishments during the past year. (See Attachment B for the application and selection criteria or consult the SCYYRA website) The application deadline is 5pm on October 12, 2012.

Series Reports

- A. North Series John Fretwell. The first North Series regatta will be at ABYC on Sept. 29-30. John will send out the advertising. He hopes to have 30 boats. Sailors must be signed up by the second regatta to be scored for the series. John encouraged parents and coaches to get on the SCYYRA mailing list. The Junior Directors get the messages and send on to their sailors.
- B. Ullman/Frost Series Andy LaDow. The first Ullman/Frost series race was held at ABYC as part of the Labor Day Regatta, Sept. 1-2, 2012. Andy reported that 33 full rigs and 41 radials raced in the ocean under good conditions. The next Ullman/Frost series races will be held at ABYC on Nov. 17-18 as part of ABYC's Turkey Day Regatta.
- C. Shadden Series— Mike Segerblom reported that 60 boats are registered for today's first race in the series. He stated that this is a record turn out for this regatta.

- D. Perry Series Jon Rogers was not present, but Andy LaDow reported that the Perry Series starts next weekend, Sept. 15-16 at CBYC.
- E. Hamlin Series- Peter Macdonald- Peter reported that he expects a few more boats in this year's Hamlin Series. He talked about US Sailing's instruction on "What to do-when the wind picks up". The key is to try not to overreact. He suggests looking at what US Sailing is doing and then what you have done. He is surprised at the low level of experience with power boats in the Level 1 clinics. He says it must improve. The 29ers are going to Orange Bowl again the world qualifier- then back to California.
- F. SoCal Opti Series Carrie Dair. Carrie was not present. It was reported from the floor that three new skippers in the Shadden Series today were SoCal Opti sailors last year.



Attached is an official application which encourages local sailors to review their past 12 months racing resume' and submit an entry. Applications are due by October 12th, 2012.

On the reverse side of this letter is a copy of the "Selection Matrix" that will be used to help select this year's elite team of sailors. As you can see, the most competitive regattas that you have sailed throughout the year are those that you should include on your application, as <u>only your top 5 regattas are considered</u> when totaling points.
