

2019 SUPER BOWL CHARITY REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is the Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club

Rules. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The following Prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply: rule *63.2* and rule *63.4*. The following Prescription of US Sailing will apply: rule *V1* Penalties at the Time of the Incident. *Appendix U* Audible-Signal Racing System may be used on any course. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

Eligibility and entry. This event is open to all boats less than 25 feet long. Expected classes include Lido 14, C-15, Snipe, CFJ/C420, Laser, RS Tera, VX One, Optimist and our hybrid Lite Green class for novices in Sabots and Optimists. The registration fee for single person boats is \$20, \$25 for two person boats and \$30 for three person boats. All entrants are encouraged to register online prior to the end of Early Registration at the end of the day January 22, 2019. After Early Registration ends, the entry fee is \$25 for single person boats, \$30 for two person boats and \$35 for three person boats. No entries will be accepted after 1000 hours the day of the regatta.

All entries shall be made online at https://www.regattatoolbox.com/register?eventID=byVByBDVA3. You will be asked to establish a free user account which protects your privacy and also allows for easy editing of your registration if needed. Each competitor attending the awards banquet will receive a raffle ticket and enjoy warm food. Additional donations may be made to the **Santa Monica Bay Sailing Foundation** (http://www.smbsf.org/) at the SMWYC Clubhouse before and after racing.

Classes. Classes will be established based upon the entries received as of the end of the day, January 22, 2019. Anticipated divisions on the Channel course are Lido 14 A, Lido 14 B, RS Tera A and Snipe, on the Ocean course Laser Standard, Laser Radial, C-15, CFJ and Optimist Race (White, Red and Blue) and on the Green course Optimist Green, RS Tera B and Sabot/Optimist Lite Green. Other classes may be created based upon entries. Three or more entries are required to assure a one-design start.

Location. Racing will be held in three separate areas. The Ocean course will be approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile northwest of the MdR detached breakwater. The Channel course will in the outer channel between the UCLA dock and the detached breakwater. The Green course will be in the main channel of Marina del Rey in the vicinity of Burton Chase Park. Approximate locations will be described on the Course Charts, which will be available with the Sailing Instructions no later than 1000 hours the morning of the regatta.

Schedule. A competitor's meeting will be held at SMWYC at 1000 hours the morning of the regatta. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1200 hours. NOTE: In the event of foul weather this regatta may be moved to Sunday, January 27.

Scoring. The Race Committees will run as many races as possible. One completed race shall constitute a regatta. A Boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes *RRS A2.1*

Launching. A hoist is available at SMWYC, 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, 310-827-7692.

Awards and Hospitality. Awards will be presented after racing at SMWYC in a festive celebration featuring a lively raffle of sponsor-provided goods along with warm and hearty food.
