1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the INSA class rules, and by the INSA Conditions for the Sabot II Championships. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligibility requirements for boats are that they are a Naples Sabot.
- 2.2 Eligibility requirements for competitors are that they are eleven (11) years of age or younger (may not turn 12 on or before Wednesday, July 10th) and that they are a 2019 member of INSA.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by 5pm on Monday, July 8th. Visit liyc.net to find the registration link. Hand delivered entries will be accepted until the close of registration Wednesday, July 10th.

3. ENTRY FEE

Time

3.1 \$20 (per boat) for registration and trophy snack.

Event

3.2 Additional \$10 Late fee for all entries received after 5pm on Monday, July 8th.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Mandatory Check –In: All competitors must check in Wednesday, July 10th between 9:30am-10:30am.

9:30-10:30	Mandatory Check-In & Late Registration
10:30	Competitor's Meeting
11:00	First Warning Signal

4.2 *** Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after race one. There will be no scheduled lunch break if sailing in flights. Sailors should eat either before the start or during their "Bye Race." If flights are not needed, there will be a 30-45 minute lunch break. No races will start after 1530.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided during Check-In on the day of the event.

6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at the Genoa Boat Garden. Please contact sailingdirector@liyc.net for more information.
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the harbor east of LIYC (Turning Basin).
- 6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.4 If needed, boats will be divided into flights by the Organizing Authority. All boats must display their flight color ribbon from either the clew of their mainsail or the end of their boom.

7. WEIGHTS

7.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event.

8. SCORING

8.1 Scoring will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.

9. TROPHIES

9.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race. Trophies will be awarded to the top 10 finishers. These sailors will be invited to participate in the Sabot II Invitational Championship the following week on Wednesday, July 17 at Mission Bay Yacht Club. There is also a trophy for the youngest sailor who completes all of the races in the North and South Championships.

10. DISCLAIMER

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
