NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The rules of the INSA Class, Laser Class, the North Series Standing Rules as published in the 2019 SCYYRA Year Book and the 2019/2020 North Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race, the Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) will apply.
- 1.3. The INSA Gross Weight Rule will apply for all "A", "B", "C1" and "Senior" skippers; no other class weight rules will be enforced.

2 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to INSA Class boats that meet the following requirements:
 - 2.1.1. The skipper shall be a member of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
 - 2.1.2. Skippers must be a member in good standing of the INSA Class.
- 2.2. This regatta is open to Sabots racing in the following fleets: Junior A, B, C1, C2, C3, Senior Sabot, and Radials.
- 2.3. The entry fee for the regatta will be \$40, which includes a t-shirt, Sat dinner party, trophy snack and trophies. Entries received after September 22, 2019 shall be subject to a \$10 late fee and t-shirt availability is not guaranteed.
- 2.4. For A Fleet only, this regatta is part of the 2019/2020 SCYYRA North Series. A \$10 series sanctioning fee will be added to A-fleet registration fees, and A-fleeters will need to complete North Series registration at www.scyyra.org (free).
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by registering online at www.sdyc.org/juniors.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-In.

5 VENUES

- 5.1. The intended venue for C2 and C3 fleets will be the La Playa basin, immediately south of SDYC.
- 5.2. The intended venue for A/B/C1/Sr/Radial fleets will be on the Shelter Island Shoal, just south of the Shelter Island basin and the Harbor Police station. Please be aware that there is no resting dock at this venue.

6 THE COURSES

6.1. Course charts will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7 RACES

- 7.1. Races will be started in accordance with RRS Appendix U (full whistle sequence).
- 7.2. A maximum of 10 races shall be sailed.

8 SCORING

- 8.1. Only after six or more races are completed, shall a boat's worst score will be excluded from her series' score. This modifies RRS Appendix A.
- 8.2. Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

9 COACH BOATS

9.1. Coaching is not allowed while competitors are racing, except in the C3 division for competitors who are substantially behind the fleet.

10 TROPHIES

10.1. Trophies will be presented to the top competitors in each fleet.

11 HOSPITALITY

11.1. A pool party and dinner is included on Sat evening, as well as a snack during trophy presentation.
