NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, by the [Club FJ Class Association \(CFJCA\) Rules](#), by the [Shadden Standing Rule](#), and by the 2019-2020 [Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race](#).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescription RRS 82 will not apply. This changes 4.1 of the Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series NoR.
- 1.3 A condition of entry and participation in this regatta is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket or, for international sailors only, a lifejacket approved by their country's corresponding authority, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. All lifejackets must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable lifejackets do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. These changes are added to RRS 40, and the Preamble to Part 4 will not apply to RRS 40. [DP]

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to Club FJ class boats that meet CFJCA rules.
- 2.2 Eligible skippers may enter their boat by completing online registration at the [Shadden #2](#) webpage and paying all fees by the entry deadline of 1800 on Saturday, October 5. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of a Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee.
- 2.3 Each competitor under the age of 18 must submit a completed [CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver](#), signed by a parent or guardian. This form can be scanned and emailed to the Regatta Chair (contact information in NoR 15) or submitted at Check-in.
- 2.4 Only entries that have completed Check-in by 0900 on Sunday, October 6 will be eligible to race. Late Check-in may be allowed only with the approval of the Regatta Chair.

3. CHECK-IN

- 3.1 Check-in will be on the CYC pool patio from 0800-0900 on Sunday, October 6.
- 3.2 To complete Check-in, each entrant shall have met all eligibility and entry requirements, paid all fees and submitted a completed [CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver](#) per NoR 2.3.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$50 for entries received by Wednesday, October 2. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$60. \$20 of the entry fee goes to SCYYRA (Series Sanction Fee) per 2.2 of the Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series NoR.

Five (5) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SI will be posted at the [Shadden #2](#) webpage by Wednesday, October 2. Course Charts will be available at Check-in.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward/leeward with some reaching legs if conditions warrant.

9. SCORING

9.1 All race scores will count.

9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10. SAFETY

Each skipper who launches their boat from CYC must sign-out prior to leaving the dock and sign-in upon return. Each skipper not launching from CYC shall notify the Regatta Chair before leaving their dock and, following the final race of the day, shall notify the Regatta Chair as soon as practical to confirm they have returned to their dock. (See NoR 15 for Regatta Chair contact information). [DP]

11. DESIGNATED ADULT

11.1 An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each competitor under the age of eighteen (18). It is solely the responsibility of this adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adult supervising the competitor is ultimately responsible for the risks. Additionally, this designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

11.2 As per NoR 2.3, each competitor under the age of 18 shall provide a completed [CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver](#), signed by a parent or guardian, indicating the name and contact information for the adult who shall be on-site, and who is authorized and designated to be responsible for that competitor during this event per NoR 11.1. [DP]

11.3 Competitors who are eighteen (18) years or older are responsible for their own actions, and for the decision to sail in weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event.

12. SUPPORT BOATS [DP]

12.1 Support boats must register with the OA and prominently display an identification flag provided by the OA. Only registered support boats will be allowed in the racing area. There will be a refundable deposit of \$20 required for each identification flag, payable on-site on October 6.

12.2 All support boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio. All individuals on such registered boats are required to wear PFDs.

12.3 The conduct of all support boats and support persons will be governed by the SI.

12.4 Support boats launched at CYC must have a CYC staff member operating the hoist at all times. These boats shall not be launched or recovered at CYC while competitors are launching or recovering their dinghies.

12.5 Competitors who wish to keep support boats at CYC must make arrangements with the Dockmaster for use of the hoist, trailer storage and in-the-water berthing. See NoR 15 for Dockmaster contact information.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
