### 1. HOST CLUBS & DATES

### 2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE & AWARDS

- 2.1 A skipper or crew cannot count a regatta in the series scoring or enter a new series if he or she is 19 years of age or older or has attended college prior to entering the series or participating in a particular Regatta.
- 2.2 Entries for the 2019/2020 Perry Series and regattas must be filed online using TheClubspot.com. This year you will be automatically entered in the Perry Series if you enter one of the regattas through TheClubspot.com. A \$20 Series entry fee from each regatta entry fee will go towards the series. If you compete in the first 2 of the 4 regattas in the series, you will get a t-shirt (or similar participation item). Using TheClubspot.com please make sure that you are entered in both the SCYYRA Perry Series AND all regattas that you will compete in.
- 2.3 Entries will only be processed online using TheClubspot.com and be accessed via the Perry Series links at [www.scyyra.org](http://www.scyyra.org)
- 2.4 All Series and Regatta Information is available via TheClubspot.com.
- 2.5 All boats must have comply with all rules of the C420 Class.

### 3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1 Competitors (skipper & crew) must be members in good standing of the Club 420 Class Association. Membership can be obtained on the Club 420 Class website at [www.club420.org](http://www.club420.org). Please include your Club 420 Class membership number when completing your online entry. Class membership information will be verified.

### 4. RULES

- 4.1 Each regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Perry Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYYRA website; the Club 420 Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club.

### 5. SCORING

- 4.1 Perry Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each race tabulated only against other Perry Series entrants.
- 4.2 Perry Series scoring shall be in accordance with US Sailing Appendix A9 (2017-2020 RRS).
- 4.3 For the Perry Series a DNC is defined as not registering for a Perry Series Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Perry Series plus one.



4.4 Ties will be broken using US SAILING Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht ahead in the final race that the two participating yachts both started.

4.5 Throwout races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

- a. If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout
- b. If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts
- c. If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts
- d. If 20 or more races are sailed, there will be 4 throwouts
- e. Sail number changes shall be reported to the Perry Series Chairman Tom Holthus at [tholthus@mccarthyholthus.com](mailto:tholthus@mccarthyholthus.com) and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
