2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. A skipper cannot count a regatta in the series scoring or enter a new series if he or she is 19 years of age or older or has attended college prior to entering the series or participating in a particular Regatta.
- 2.2. Entries for the 2019/2020 Ullman/Frost Series and each separate Ullman/Frost Series Regattas must be filed online using TheClubspot.com. You need to complete an entry for each Ullman/Frost Series Regatta and a separate entry (one time - free) for the 2019-20 Ullman/Frost Series itself. A \$10 Series Sanction Fee from each regatta will go to SCYRA (This is the Series Entry Fee). If you compete in the first 2 of the 4 regattas in the series, you will get a t-shirt (or similar participation item). Using TheClubspot.com please make sure that you are entered in both the SCYRA Ullman/Frost Series AND all regattas that you will compete in.
- 2.3. Entries will only be processed online using TheClubspot.com and can be accessed via the Ullman/Frost Series links at www.scyyra.org
- 2.4. All Series and Regatta Information is available via TheClubspot at:
- 2.5. All boats must be class legal according to the International Laser Class Association North American Region.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1. All skippers shall be a member in good standing of the International Laser Class Association North American Region.
- 3.2. Membership can be obtained on the Laser Class website at www.laser.org -click on "Join the Class". Junior class membership (under 18 years old) is approximately \$45. Please include your Laser Class membership number when completing your on line entry. Class membership information will be verified.

4. RULES

- 4.1. Each regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Ullman/Frost Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYRA Website; the Laser Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club. See http://www.scyyra.org/ullman_frost/c/C18 for more info.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. The Low-Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with 20 or more races scheduled. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the series. A DNF, DSQ and DNS will be based on the total number of Ullman/Frost Series starters in each individual regatta.
- 5.2. Throwout races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
 - If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout
 - If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts
 - If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts
 - If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.
- 5.3. Sail number and crew changes must be approved by the Ullman/Frost Series Chairman, John Long and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
- 5.4. **Races sailed on Fridays of three-day events will not be incorporated into the series scoring.**
