2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. A skipper cannot count a regatta in the series scoring or enter a new series if he or she is 19 years of age or older or has attended college prior to entering the series or participating in a particular Regatta.
- 2.2. Entries for the 2019/2020 Ullman/Frost Series and each separate Ullman/Frost Series Regattas must be filed online using TheClubspot.com. You need to complete an entry for each Ullman/Frost Series Regatta and a separate entry (one time free) for the 2019-20 Ullman/Frost Series itself. A \$10 Series Sanction Fee from each regatta will go to SCYYRA (This is the Series Entry Fee). If you compete in the first 2 of the 4 regattas in the series, you will get a t-shirt (or similar participation item). Using TheClubspot.com please make sure that you are entered in both the SCYYRA Ullman/Frost Series AND all regattas that you will compete in.
- 2.3. Entries will only be processed online using TheClupspot.com and can be accessed via the Ullman/Frost Series links at www.scyyra.org
- 2.4. All Series and Regatta Information is available via TheClubspot at:
- 2.5. All boats must be class legal according to the International Laser Class Association North American Region.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1. All skippers shall be a member in good standing of the International Laser Class Association North American Region.
- 3.2. Membership can be obtained on the Laser Class website at www.laser.org -click on "Join the Class". Junior class membership (under 18 years old) is approximately \$45. Please include your Laser Class membership number when completing your on line entry. Class membership information will be verified.

4. RULES

4.1. Each regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Ullman/Frost Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYYRA Website; the Laser Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club. See http://www.scyyra.org/ullman_frost/c/C18 for more info.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. The Low-Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with 20 or more races scheduled. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the series. A DNF, DSQ and DNS will be based on the total number of Ullman/Frost Series starters in each individual regatta.
- 5.2. Throwout races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
 - If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout
 - If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts
 - If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts
 - If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.
- 5.3. Sail number and crew changes must be approved by the Ullman/Frost Series Chairman, John Long and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
- 5.4. Races sailed on Fridays of three-day events will not be incorporated into the series scoring.
