## NOTICE OF RACE



### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the CFJ Class, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. There will be a limit of 18 teams accepted through Monday, January 13, 2020, 1600PST. Any teams to be accepted after this deadline are at the discretion of the host. **No organization may enter more than two teams and the host reserves the right to decide on organizational affiliation.**
- 2.2. The regatta will be sailed in CFJs provided by the host.
- 2.3. Teams may enter by completing the online entry at [www.sdyc.org/juniors](http://www.sdyc.org/juniors).
- 2.4. Each team will consist of three boats, including three skippers and three crews in order to qualify for entry into the regatta. Substitutions will only be allowed at the discretion of the Principle Race Officer.
- 2.5. **Each registered team shall provide a coach (or proxy), unique to that single team, who has the appropriate knowledge and physical capabilities to officiate team racing on the water.** The plan for officiating this event will be to have, at minimum, the two coaches of the competing teams umpire that race from a shared chase boat.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee is \$160 per team.
- 3.2. Each team must also supply a \$250 damage deposit in the form of a check prior to the close of regatta registration.
- 3.3. Entry fee includes usage of provided boats and sails, trophies for the top three finishing teams and lunch on Monday only.

- 4.2. The regatta format and the number of races will be determined by the Principal Race Officer and will be based on the number of teams registered and the weather conditions. Possible formats include but are not limited to: Round Robin, Split Fleet Round Robin, and Elimination Ladder, followed by quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals. The format to be attempted,

contingency formats (if any) and changes to the format will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided at check-in.

### 6. VENUE

- 6.1. The intended racing area will be in the basin between San Diego and Southwestern Yacht Clubs. Rotations will be off the SDYC Race Dock (E) and viewing is available from the docks and shore.

### 7. COURSES

- 7.1. The course will be any variation of the N-course.

### 8. EQUIPMENT

- 8.1. Club Flying Juniors and sails will be provided by the host.
- 8.2. Boats will be rigged and inspected prior to the first race as part of a team's Check-In process.
- 8.3. Standing rigging shall not be adjusted without prior permission of the Regatta Chairmen and, if applicable, the Chief Umpire/Judge.
- 8.4. Competitors will be responsible for damage to boats as a result of a foul or negligence.

### 9. AWARDS

- 9.1. The winning team will receive the SCYA Harold Adams Team Race Perpetual. Top three teams will receive awards.
