NOTICE OF RACE

DECEMBER 26 to 30, 2020

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Prescriptions to RRS 60.3, 67, 70.5(a), 76.1, 61.4 and Appendix R shall apply.
- 1.3 In all Optimist classes RRS 61 will be changed as follows: The red protest flag required in Rule 61.1(a) shall be attached to the lifejacket in a manner that conceals it until displayed. Further changes to Rule 61.1 may be part of the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the American English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 Competitors shall wear a properly secured personal flotation device at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothes.
- 1.6 Appendix P will be in effect and may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.7 Class rules regarding qualifying events and championships will not apply.
- 1.8 In accordance with RRS G3, a boat chartered or loaned for this event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.

2 ADVERTISING AND BOAT IDENTIFICATION

Boats may be required to display additional identification numbers on their sail or bow. Boats may also be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to competitors 18 years of age or younger on December 26, 2020 who declare they are members of US Sailing, or their national authority, and their respective class association.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to all boats of the Club 420, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and Optimist classes with a maximum number of boats in each class as follows:
 - 100 Club 420s
 - 150 Lasers (Standard, Radial and 4.7 combined)
 - 240 Optimist (Red, Blue and White combined)
 - 70 Optimist Green.

- 3.3 Optimist age groups are based on their age on December 26, 2020:
 White - Ten (10) years old or younger
 Blue - Eleven (11) or twelve (12) years old
 Red - Thirteen (13) to fifteen (15) years old
 Green – Novice sailors of any age who have NOT previously competed in RWB events
- 3.4 Registration will open:
 October 5, 2020 0900 EST for the Optimist Class (Red, White, Blue and Green Fleets)
 October 6, 2020 0900 EST for Club 420 and Lasers
- 3.5 After registration opens eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at **REGISTRATION**
- 3.6 Online registration will close:
 December 14, 2020, 2400 EST. Additional entries will be at the sole discretion of the OA.
- 3.7 Registration is not complete until payment has been made and the Sailor Waiver has been signed online. A waitlist will be created when a class has reached the maximum number of entries. When a spot opens the next entry on the waitlist will be registered. To be placed on the waitlist, full payment and a Sailor Waiver is required. Sailors not moved off the wait list will receive a full refund.
- 3.8 Sailors who have not completed the Sailor Waiver by November 14, 2020 will not be registered and will forfeit their registration and their fee.

4 FEES

- 4.1 A refund, less a \$150 processing fee, will be granted to those entries canceled by 1800 hrs, November 14, 2020.
- 4.2 Coach and Spectator Boats - All coach and spectator boats must register with the organizing authority on-site at Coral Reef Yacht Club on December 26 and provide the names of competitors they support. A fee of \$80.00 per boat is required at the time of registration and will be refunded when the issued ID flag is returned at the end of the regatta. In addition, each boat must carry a VHF radio, monitoring the channel provided for each of their sailors' course at all times while on the water.
- 4.3 All fees are USD. All fees include state and local taxes. All times and dates are EST.

5 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

All classes may be divided into two or more divisions at the discretion of the OA.

6 VENUE

The location of the regatta will be on Biscayne Bay.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and online prior to the regatta.

9 BERTHING

- 9.1 Club 420 classes will be launched, hauled and stored at the US Sailing Center.
- 9.2 Laser, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 classes will be launched, hauled and stored at Shake-a-Leg Miami.
- 9.3 Optimist class will be launched, hauled and stored at Coral Reef Yacht Club and the US Sailing Center.
- 9.4 Each boat is to have its own dolly.

10 CHARTERS

Club 420, Laser and Optimist charters are to be obtained from Orange Bowl International Youth Regatta approved charter companies only. Approved charter companies can be found in event website.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Twelve (12) races are scheduled for Opti RWB, all Laser fleets and C420s. Total races for Opti Green will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 11.2 A boat's worst score will be excluded with the completion of five (5) or more races.

12 PRIZES

Top Daily Sailor Orange Jersey award- Top sailor at end of each day in each class will receive an Orange Bowl jersey.
