Organizing Authority: Newport Harbor Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 Sabot A, B, and C1 fleet boats may be subject to on-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to INSA class rules for a list of required equipment.
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Jr. Sabot A, B, C1, C2, and C3 boats whose skipper is a member in good standing of INSA.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online <u>www.nhyc.org</u>, on or before Friday 2/7/20 by 5pm. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

3.1 <u>Mandatory check-in</u> for all competitors will be Saturday 2/9 from 8:30am until 10:30am on the sailing patio at NHYC. A competitor must check-in prior to his fleet Skippers' meeting.

Weigh In: Sabot A and B sailors may be required to weigh-in during their mandatory check-in.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available no later than check-in on Saturday morning.

5. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

- 5.1 Race Venue 1: Harbor north of the Main Dock of NHYC.
- 5.2 Race Venue 2: Harbor north of the Main Dock of NHYC.
- 5.3 The course may be a windward leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6. FORMAT & SCORING

6.1 The regatta format will be determined at the close of registration based on the number of entries in each fleet and the forecasted weather conditions. It is the intent of the race committee to sail fleets that exceed 36

entries in flights.

- 6.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 6.3 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of entrants in each fleet in accordance with the following schedule:
