## NOTICE OF RACE



### 1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of US SAILING.
- 1.2. The rules of the CFJ Class, the Shadden Series Standing Rules as published in the 2019 SCYYRA Year Book. The Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions will also apply.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to CFJ Class boats that meet the following requirements:
  - a. The skipper and crew shall be under 19 years of age and shall not have entered college.
  - b. The skipper and crew shall be members of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
  - c. Both skipper & crew member on each boat must be a member, in good standing, of SCYYRA.

- 3.2. No race shall be started after 1530 on Sunday.
- 3.3. Snacks and Trophy Presentation to follow racing.

### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the registration website.

### 5 RACING

- 5.1. The racing area will be approximately 1 NM southeast of Zuniga Jetty in the area known as the Coronado Roads.
- 5.2. Sailors should be prepared for a long day on the water. Lunch IS **NOT** provided.
- 5.3. All boats must have a CFJ-class-legal tow line for towing purposes.

**6 COURSES**

6.1. The courses to be sailed will be as follows: triangle, windward-leeward, or any combination thereof.

**7 PENALTY SYSTEM**

7.1. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply.

**8 SCORING**

8.1. This regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A using the Low Point System modified such no scores shall be discarded.

8.2. Two races will constitute a regatta.

**9 SUPPORT/SPECTATOR BOATS**

9.1. Spectator boats will not be provided.

9.2. Team leaders, coaches *and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until* all boats have finished the race or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

9.3. Coach boats must be stored at our Guest dock C3 & C4 overnight. Side tying will need to occur to accommodate all coach boats.

**10 TRAILERS**

10.1. All trailers should be stored in the designated trailer parking spots.

10.2. Competitors must provide their own dollies and all boats must be clear of the fire lanes.

10.3. Support boats will be berthed at our A Dock guest spots. See attachment of dock maps for exact location. Side tying will need to occur to fit all boats. No boats may be tied up in private slips.

**11 TROPHIES**

11.1. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top five teams for less than 40 teams entered or top 10 for 40+ teams registered at the regatta. Additionally the top U16 team overall in which both the skipper and crew are under 16 years old throughout 2021.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13 HOSPITALITY**

13.1. Complimentary breakfast will be provided both days for registered skippers and crews.

13.2. There will be snacks for competitors after racing.

13.3. Guests may register with the SWYC front desk for a guest card. The dining room and bar will open at 0800.
