1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority is Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association (SCYYRA)
- 1.2. This Series shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Carrie Series Rules as on the SCYYRA Website, the USODA Class Rules, this Notice of Series and the Sailing Instructions issued by each host venue.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA).

3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & FEES

- 3.1 A skipper is not eligible for regattas or the series if he or she turns 16 in the calendar year of the regatta.
- 3.2 The SCYYRA Carrie Series is open to International Optimist Dinghy class boats.
- 3.3 Participants must be members of a current SCYYRA organization to be eligible for the SCYYRA Carrie Series Perpetual Trophy. Carrie Series Entry is automatic with the entry in a Carrie Series event.
- 3.4 Each individual regatta in the series must be entered in accordance with the individual regatta notice of race.
- 3.5 A \$10 SCYYRA Sanctioning Fee from each regatta will go to SCYYRA. (This is instead of a Series Entry Fee).

5. SCORING

- 5.1 The Low Point system of Appendix A will apply with the following modifications:
Throwout races will be incorporated into the Series scoring with the following formulas: If 11-15 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts. If 16-20 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts. If 21-25 races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts. If 25-30 races are completed, there will be 5 throwouts. If 31-35 races are completed, there will be 6 throwouts. If 36 or more races are completed, there will be 8 throwouts.
- 5.2 Sail number changes in any regatta must be reported to the Series Chairman (or representative) and reported to the race committee prior to the skippers meeting for that Regatta for those races to be scored in the Series.

5.3 A boat that did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the individual event. This changes Rule A4.2.

6. TROPHIES

6.1 The SCYYRA Carrie Series Perpetual Trophy shall be awarded at the end of the last event of the series to the junior who has the lowest cumulative point score for the scheduled regattas using the scoring system explained above. The name of the winner shall be inscribed on Perpetual Trophy. The perpetual trophy shall be kept for that year in the Yacht Club of the winning skipper. If the club does not have adequate facilities to retain the trophy, it shall then reside at a place determined by the SCYYRA Board of Directors

6.2 Takehome trophies shall be awarded to some number of finishers in the series
