### 1 HOST CLUBS AND DATES

Hamlin 3 Mid-March TBD, 2025, 29er Mid Winters West, LOCATION TBD

Hamlin 4 Mid- May TBD, 2025, Skiff Fest, Santa Barbara Yacht Club

### 2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, and ENTRY FEE

- 2.1 All participating juniors (under the age of 19 years during the entire Series) must be a SCYYRA or SCYA yacht club member.
- 2.2 A participant must be eligible to enter each regatta under 29er class rules.
- 2.3 Entries for the 2024-2025 Hamlin Series must be submitted on [theclubspot.com](https://www.theclubspot.com), <https://www.scyyra.org/series/20/hamlin-info> (entry here is free, for ease of entry please use the Chrome browser). Skippers should enter the Hamlin Series jointly for each pairing (if there is a change in partners during the series, please register the new pairing). To uphold the spirit of the Hamlin award, where the skipper and crew are equally important to the sailing of the 29er sailboat, the series awards go to individual sailors versus the team. There is not a Series team award. At conclusion of the series, series scoring and recognition will be given independently to the top overall scoring Skipper and top overall scoring Crew. An entry must also be completed for each individual regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event.
- 2.4 There will be a \$20 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee per regatta that will be added onto each regatta's entry fee. The entry fee includes series trophies and a series souvenir for each skipper and crew. Series souvenirs are only guaranteed for series competitors who have entered the series by the close of registration for the second regatta.

### 3 CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1 Hamlin Series participants (skipper & crew) must be members in good standing of the 29er Class Association, no later than the close of registration at the second regatta.

### 4 RULES

- 4.1 Each regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US SAILING, Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYYRA website, 29er Class rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each host club.

### 5 SCORING

- 5.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with 20 or more races scheduled. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the series. A DNF, DSQ and DNS will be based on the total number of Hamlin Series starters in each individual regatta.
- 5.2 Throw out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
- If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throw out
  - If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throw outs
  - If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throw outs
  - If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throw outs
- 5.3 Sail number and crew changes must be reported and approved by the Hamlin Series Chair and reported to the race committee prior to the skippers meeting for that regatta to be scored for those races.
