2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA Shadden Series Perpetual Trophy, participants must be members in good standing of a current SCYYRA organization.
- 2.2. A participant must be eligible to enter each regatta under CFJ Class rules.
- 2.3. All participants in Shadden Series regattas must be SCYYRA members in good standing. Lifetime membership is free and can be completed here via Clubspot.
- 2.4. All participants in Shadden Series regattas must be registered for the 2025-2026 Shadden Series. Entries must be submitted on theclubspot.com (for ease of entry please use the Chrome browser). An entry must also be completed for each individual regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event.
- 2.5. A participant may enter the series at the first, second, or third scheduled regatta but no later than the close of registration at the third regatta.
- 2.6. There will be a \$20.00 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee per regatta that will be added onto each regatta's entry fee. The entry fee includes Series trophies and a Series participation souvenirs for each skipper and crew. Series souvenirs are only guaranteed for Series competitors who have entered the Series by the close of registration for the second regatta.

2.7. All boats must have a valid measurement certificate on file with the CFJ Class Secretary. If your boat has not been measured, contact info@scyyra.org to arrange measurement with the CFJ Class Secretary.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1. Shadden Series participants, *both* skipper and crew, must be CFJ Class members in good standing. CFJ Class Membership information can be found at www.cfjclass.org.
- 3.2. Lists of current CFJ Class members, measured CFJs, CFJ Class Rules, and Shadden Series Results can be found on www.cfjclass.org.

4. RULES

- 4.1. Each regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US SAILING, Shadden Series Rules as published on the SCYYRA website, CFJ Class rules, this Notice of Series, and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions issued by each host club.
- 4.2. CFJ Class Rule 34 concerning the weight of the boat will be in effect. If correcting weight is required, it shall be permanently affixed in accordance with Rule 34.
- 4.3. CFJ Class Rule 35 concerning crew weight will be in effect (the combined weight shall be 240 lbs/108.9 kg; however, no crew shall carry more than 25 lbs/11.3 kg).

5. SCORING

- 5.1. Low point scoring system, Appendix A4 will apply.
- 5.2. Series scoring will be based on the official results of each regatta tabulated only against other Shadden Series entrants.
- 5.3. There may be 20 or more races scheduled and sailed in the Shadden Series.
- 5.4. Ties will be broken using RRS Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht finishing ahead in the final race that the yachts in question both started.
- 5.5. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the series. A DNF, DSQ and DNS will be based on the total number of Shadden Series starters in each individual regatta.

5.6. Throw-out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

- If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throw-out.
- If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throw-outs.
- If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throw-outs.
- If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throw-outs.

5.6. Sail number and crew changes must be reported and approved by the Shadden Series Chair (or representative) and reported to the race committee <u>prior</u> to the start of racing each day.
