2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE

2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA Ullman/Frost Series Perpetual Trophy, participants must be members in good standing of a current SCYYRA organization.

2.2. A participant must be eligible to enter each regatta under International Laser Class Association North America Region Class rules.

2.3. All participants in Ullman/Frost Series regattas must be SCYYRA members in good standing. Lifetime membership is free and can be completed [here via Clubspot](#).

2.4. All participants in Ullman/Frost Series regattas must be registered for the 2025-2026 Ullman/Frost Series. Entries must be submitted on theclubspot.com (for ease of entry please use the Chrome browser). An entry must also be completed for each individual regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event.

2.5. A participant may enter the series at the first, second, or third scheduled regatta but no later than the close of registration at the third regatta.

2.6. There will be a \$10.00 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee per regatta that will be added onto each regatta's entry fee. The entry fee includes Series trophies and a Series participation souvenirs for each skipper. Series souvenirs are only guaranteed for Series competitors who have entered the Series by the close of registration for the second regatta.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

3.1. Ullman/Frost Series participants must be International Laser Class Association North America Region members in good standing. ILCA-NA Class Membership information can be found at www.ilcanasailing.org.

4. RULES

4.1. Each regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US SAILING, Ullman/Frost Series Rules as published on the SCYYRA website, ILCA-NA Class rules, this Notice of Series, and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions issued by each host club.

4.2. All boats must be class legal according to ILCA-NA.

5. SCORING

5.1. Low point scoring system, Appendix A4 will apply.

5.2. Series scoring will be based on the official results of each regatta tabulated only against other Ullman/Frost Series entrants.

5.3. There may be 20 or more races scheduled and sailed in the Ullman/Frost Series.

5.4. A DNC is defined as not entering an Ullman/Frost Series Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Ullman/Frost Series plus one.

5.4. Ties will be broken using RRS Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht finishing ahead in the final race that the yachts in question both started.

5.5. Throw-out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

- If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throw-out.
- If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throw-outs.
- If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throw-outs.
- If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throw-outs.

5.6. Races sailed on the first day of a three-day event will not be incorporated into the Series scoring.

5.7. Sail number changes must be reported and approved by the Ullman/Frost Series Chair (or representative) and reported to the race committee prior to the start of racing each day to be scored for those races in the Series.
