1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitor's Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 will be changed as follows: USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A, RS Teras, and CFJs. Additional fleets may be eligible to participate with written request and approval from Lido Isle Yacht Club's Sailing Director.
- **2.2** 3 boats will make a class.
- **2.3** Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee by 5:00pm one day prior to the event. All entries received on/after Monday, October 13th will be subject to a \$10 late fee. All registrations received on/after Friday, October 17th will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Registration fees are non-refundable.

3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Please note: A \$10 late fee will be assessed for entries starting October 13th. A \$25 late fee will be in effect on October 17th. Online registration closes October 18th at 5pm.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available on ClubSpot one day prior to the regatta.

6 VENUE

- **6.1** Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Turning Basin dependent on participation and wind direction.
- **6.2** Courses may be split depending on the number of participants.

7 COURSES

7.1 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

- **8.1** Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- **8.2** (a) When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9 PRIZES

9.1 Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be

responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
