NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Racing rule(s) 26, 33, 35, 40.1, 44.1, 44.2, and 61.3 will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.2. Competitors shall wear USCG-approved PFDs at all times while on the water, other than during brief periods while adding or removing clothing. RRS 40.1 shall apply. This modifies the preamble to Part 4.

2 ADVERTISING

This is a "Category A" event for Sabots (no advertising) and a "Category C" event for ILCA 4, 6 & 7.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Naples Sabot, ILCA 4, 6 and 7 classes.
- 3.2. Online Registration will be available at: https://theclubspot.com/regatta/qTV6hQ6CYk
- 3.4. Fees: the registration fee shall be \$60 if the sailor has registered online before October 20th, 2025. If registering on or after October 20th, the fee will be \$75. Sabot A, ILCA 6 & 7 fleet sailors will be charged an additional \$10 for the SCYYRA North & Ullman/Frost Series'. Fees cover two days of sailing, regatta shirt, Saturday BBQ and Cornhole Tournament, trophy snack, and trophies.
- 3.5. For the ILCA 6 & 7 fleet, this regatta is part of the 2025-2026 SCYYRA Ullman/Frost Series. All ILCA 6 & 7 competitors must be registered for the 2025-2026 Ullman/Frost Series. Series registration can be completed here: https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TFp80KBrGJ/class.
- 3.6. For the Sabot A fleet, this regatta is part of the 2025-2026 North Series. All Sabot A fleet competitors must be registered for the 2025-2026 North Series. Series registration can be completed here: https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TFp80KBrGJ/class.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Regatta Website on October 30th.

6 VENUE

Sabot A, B, and C1 will take place in the mid-Sail Bay portion of Mission Bay. Sabot C2 and C3 sailors will race in "Chicken Cove". ILCA 4, 6 and 7 fleets will race in North Sail Bay.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

For SABOTS ONLY 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required.

9 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1. Support boats shall be required to monitor the appropriate Race Committee VHF channel and respond as requested.
- 10.2. Coaching is not allowed while competitors are racing, except in the C3 division for competitors that are substantially behind in the fleet.
- 10.3. Competitors that are well behind in the fleet may be given a finish score while they are on the course.
- 10.4. We ask that all PARENTS enjoy the club and viewing, but please stay OFF the water and docks. Please let the kids and coaches enjoy the weekend of learning, making new friends and enjoying healthy competition.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given in each Sabot fleet and ILCA 4, 6 and 7 fleets (3 or more boats).

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 CLUB RULES

MBYC is a dog free club. Please plan accordingly.

17 TRAILERS

- 17.1. All trailers shall be stored along the North & West fenceline inside the yacht club. Any trailer parked in the main area of the parking lot may be moved at the discretion of the yacht club.
- 17.2. Competitors must provide their own dollies, and all boats must be clear of the fire lanes.
- 17.3. Support boats may be stored in the CC & DD rigging docks, provided they remain clear of the designated fire lanes. No boats may be tied up in private slips.
