NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028</u> (RRS), by the current <u>Club FJ Class Association (CFJCA) Rules</u>, by the <u>Shadden Standing Rule</u>, and by the 2025-2026 Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series <u>Notice of Race</u>.
- 1.2 [DP] RRS 40, Personal Flotation Devices, is replaced with the following: A condition of entry and participation in this event is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD) or, for international sailors only, a PFD approved by their country's corresponding authority, properly secured at all times while on the water, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. All PFDs must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable lifejackets do not constitute adequate PFDs. The Preamble to Part 4 does not apply to RRS 40.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescription RRS 81 does not apply. This changes the Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted by Wednesday, October 1 on the Official Notice Board. Course Charts will be available at Check-in.

3. COMMUNICATION

The Official Notice Board is the Shadden Series #2 webpage on the CYC website.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to Club FJ class boats that meet CFJCA rules.
- 4.2 To compete in the Shadden Series, eligible skippers must complete two registrations:
 - (a) Entries for the 2025-2026 Shadden Series must be submitted on theclubspot.com.
 - (b) Entries for Shadden #2 must be submitted by completing online registration at the Official Notice Board and paying all fees by the entry deadline of 1800 on Friday, October 3. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of the Event Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee.
- 4.3 Each competitor under the age of eighteen (18), no later than Check-in of the Shadden Series #2, must complete an on-line CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver, signed by a parent or quardian.
- 4.4 Only entries that have completed Check-in by 0930 on Sunday, October 5 are eligible to race. Late Check-in may be allowed only with the approval of the Event Chair.

5. CHECK-IN

- 5.1 Check-in is on the CYC pool patio adjacent to the Jr. Sailing Center between 0830 and 0930 on Sunday, October 5.
- 5.2 Sail number and crew changes must be reported and approved by the <u>Shadden Series Chair</u> (or representative) and reported at Check-in prior to the start of racing each day.
- To complete Check-in, each entrant shall have met all eligibility and entry requirements, paid all fees and submitted a completed CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver per this NoR 4.3.

6. FEES

The entry fee is \$60 for entries received by Wednesday, September 24. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$75. The entry fee includes the \$20 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee.

7. SCHEDULE

Five (5) races are scheduled. The Race Committee, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

8. VENUE

The starting area is on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

9. THE COURSES

The courses are windward/leeward.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3 The Shadden Series shall be scored per the Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race.

11. SAFETY

[DP] Each skipper who launches their boat from CYC must sign-out prior to leaving the dock and sign-in upon return. Each skipper not launching from CYC shall notify the Event Chair before leaving their dock and, following the final race of the day, shall notify the Event Chair as soon as practical to confirm they have returned to their dock. 12. DESIGNATED ADULT

- 12.1 An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each competitor under the age of eighteen (18). It is solely the responsibility of this adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adult supervising the competitor is ultimately responsible for the risks. Additionally, this designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the event.
- 12.2 [DP] Each competitor under the age of eighteen (18), no later than Check-in of the Shadden Series #2, shall complete an on-line CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver, signed by a parent or guardian, indicating the name and contact information for the adult who shall be on-site, and who is authorized and designated to be responsible for that competitor during the event per this NoR 4.3 and 12.1.
- 12.3 Competitors who are eighteen (18) years or older are responsible for their own actions, and for the decision to sail in weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event.

13. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 13.1 [DP] Competitors who wish to keep SPVs at CYC must make prior arrangements with the CYC Waterfront Director for use of the hoist, trailer storage and in-the-water berthing. See this NoR 16 for contact information for the Waterfront Director.
- 13.2 [DP] All SPVs shall carry and monitor a VHF radio capable of communicating on normal domestic and international channels.
- 13.3 The conduct of SPVs and support persons is governed by the SIs.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1 The awards ceremony will be held at CYC after racing.
- 14.2 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries.

15. RISK STATEMENT

Competitors in the event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in the event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for the event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
