NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of US SAILING.
- 1.2. RRS 35, 40, and Race Signals will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. If there is a discrepancy between the NOR and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Registration will be available at www.sdyc.org/juniors.
- 2.2. The entry fee is \$110 per boat if received before Wednesday April 2nd at Midnight PDT, which includes this event, as well as \$20 to SCYYRA for Perry Series fees. Entries may be received until 0945 on Sat, April 5th with a \$40 late fee (total \$150).

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in and will be posted online.

5 RACING

- 5.1. The racing area will be approximately 1 NM southeast of Zuniga Jetty in the area known as the Coronado Roads.
- 5.2. The starting area is approximately 4.5 NM from SDYC. Competitors are advised to organize towing to the racing area with a private support boat. The OA and RC will not be providing competitor tows to the racing area.
- 5.3. Sailors should bring adequate clothing, food, and water to be prepared for a long day on the water.

6 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply.

7 SCORING

- 7.1. This regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A using the Low Point System modified such that only if six or more races are scored, each boat's worst score shall be discarded. Two races will constitute a regatta.

8 SUPPORT/SPECTATOR BOATS

- 8.1. Spectator boats will not be provided.
- 8.2. Support boats must have a working VHF Radio capable of transmitting on VHF 16, 69, and 73.
- 8.3. Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished the race or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

9 TROPHIES

- 9.1. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top five teams at the regatta.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

TRAILERS

- All trailers should be stored in the lot adjacent to the ILCA racks and dry yard storage along Anchorage Ln; any trailer parked along the side fence may be moved or towed at the discretion of the dockmaster.
- Competitors must provide their own dollies, and all boats must be clear of the fire lanes.
- Support boats will be berthed in the whaler slip adjacent to the Jr. Dock. No boats may be tied up in private slips.
