# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The fleet race regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix U.
- 1.2 The team race regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the Team Racing Rules (Appendix D), except those altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 All boats must be in compliance with INSA rules. Correction weights will be required in accordance with INSA Gross Weight Rule, Section A
- 1.4 The organizing authority (OA) is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Jr. Naples Sabot A, B, C1, C2, C3 boats. Five boats for fleet racing will be required for their own start.
- 2.2 Sailors can register for either fleet racing or team racing which will be 3v3.
- 2.3 In order to register for team racing, you must have 3 sailors per team. Every team race team shall be accompanied by a coach and capable of serving as an umpire.
- 2.4 There will be ten berths available for the team race regatta; first come, first served.
- 2.5 Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.6 Eligible boats may enter online by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee at www.nhyc.org.

  The entry fee for this regatta is \$30 and includes a hat (if you register by October 1), snacks and trophies.
- 2.7 No race entry will be accepted after 1700 hrs Friday, October 24th.

# 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

## 5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 5.1 Race Venue 1: Harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 5.2 Race Venue 2: Lido Channel.
- 5.3 The fleet courses for all classes will be windward leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.
- 5.4 The team race courses will be the digital N.

### 6. FORMAT & SCORING

- 6.1 Fleet Race Format: Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a fleet race series.
- 6.2 Fleet Race Scoring: When five (4) or fewer fleet races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

6.3 The Sailing Instructions will describe the Team Racing format. The format will be based on the number of teams entered and may include a round robin and a knockout series.

#### 7. TROPHIES

- 7.1 Trophies for top finisher in each class will be given their trophy after racing on October 26th.
- 7.2 The Non-Calm Bowl, a perpetual trophy, will be awarded to the boat finishing first in the largest class.
