### 2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE

2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA Hamlin Series Perpetual Trophy, participants must be members in good standing of a current SCYYRA organization.

2.2. A participant must be eligible to enter each regatta under 29er Class rules.

2.3. All participants in Hamlin Series regattas must be SCYYRA members in good standing. Lifetime membership is free and can be completed here:

2.4. All participants in Hamlin Series regattas must be registered for the 2025-2026 Hamlin Series. Entries must be submitted here: <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/TFp8OKBrGJ> (for ease of entry please use the Chrome browser). An entry must also be completed for each individual regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event. Skippers and Crew should register for the Series independently. To uphold the spirit of the Hamlin award, where the Skipper and Crew are equally important to the sailing of the 29er vessel, Series awards will go to the individual sailors versus the team. There is not a Series team award. At the conclusion of the Series, Series scoring and recognition will be given independently to the top overall scoring Skipper and the top overall scoring Crew.

2.5. A participant may enter the series at the first, second, or third scheduled regatta but no later than the close of registration at the third regatta.

2.6. There will be a \$20.00 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee per regatta that will be added onto each regatta's entry fee. The entry fee includes Series trophies and a Series participation souvenirs for each skipper and crew. Series souvenirs are only guaranteed for Series competitors who have entered the Series by the close of registration for the second regatta.

### **3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP**

3.1. Hamlin Series participants must be 29er Class members in good standing. 29er Class Membership information can be found at [www.us29er.org](http://www.us29er.org).

### **4. RULES**

4.1. Each regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US SAILING, Hamlin Series Rules as published on the SCYYRA website, 29er Class rules, this Notice of Series, and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions issued by each host club.

### **5. SCORING**

5.1. Low point scoring system, Appendix A4 will apply. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the Series. A DNF, DSQ, and DNF will be based on the total number of Hamlin Series starters in each individual regatta.

5.2. Series scoring will be based on the official results of each regatta tabulated only against other Hamlin Series entrants.

5.3. There may be 20 or more races scheduled and sailed in the Hamlin Series.

5.4. Ties will be broken using RRS Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht finishing ahead in the final race that the yachts in question both started.

5.5. Throw-out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

- If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout.
- If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts.
- If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts.
- If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.

5.6. Sail number and crew changes must be reported and approved by the Hamlin Series Chair (or representative) and reported to the race committee prior to the skippers meeting for that regatta to be scored for those races.
